

Carter Wins both Scratch & Handicap Divisions @ Senior Event #2

Sam Carter may have had a big “B” on his shirt, but his bowling was all “A’s” at Bowlbayarea.com’s latest senior event. Carter won both the scratch for \$320 & the handicap division for \$190 at the May 16th tournament.

Sam’s 5-game total of 1251 was paced by totaling 781 for the final 3 games (246-278-257). In the scratch division, Carter didn’t take the lead until game 4. Gary Amantite led for the first 3 games (743), but struggled a bit late and finished 3rd with an 1158 total & won \$120.

Dennis Jones was looking to defend his scratch title from the 1st Senior event and his total of 1196 would probably win a lot of tournaments, but just not this one. Back to back 259’s in games 3 & 4 were the high games of his day and his 2nd place finish netted him \$200.

Our 4th & 5th place cashers Dan Roberts (1139 for \$80) & Chet Steengrafe (1136 for \$60) each had big final games to get in the money. Dan had 269 in game 5 & Chet’s game 5 was 258.

On the handicap side, Larry Bock was the early leader, but nobody was going to keep up with Carter. Larry hung on for 2nd place & \$140 with his 1200 total.

Roger Stroh’s best game was his first (211), then overcame his worst game (137), and finished with 3 good games to capture 3rd place and take home \$100.

Larry Colombo used a big final game (278) to jump from out of the money to a total of 1162 & 4th place for \$70 and Charles Ransom, Sr. rounded out the cashers with 1136 for \$50.
