

Haggerty & Hung Highlight USBC Warm-Up Event

P.J. Haggerty & Mike Hung turned in the best individual performances in the USBC Warm Up-Event at Earl Anthony's Dublin Bowl on April 30 & May 1.

Hung threw the tournament's only perfect game in the middle of his singles event. The 300 was sandwiched by games of 255 & 208. His 763 total was 45 pins better than Andy Olech's 2nd place finish with 289/718. Mike also took 3rd in the all events category.

Haggerty took the All-Events title and was on the champions of the team event as well as one half of the top doubles squad. Hung, meanwhile, saved his best for last as he took the singles crown.

Haggerty's team posted a 1044 third game to erase a 15 pin deficit and post a 3004-3002 win over Nick Adams' team.

In the doubles event, P.J. blasted a 256-736 and teamed with Steve Ting (210-604) for a 1340 score, which was 38 pins better than Charles Nelson (650) & Dave Houck's (652) 1302.

All told, Haggerty had 5 games over the 225 mark to post an all events score of 1991, which was 15 pins better than Marty Deh. Marty had the tournament's 2nd best series, a 737 in the doubles event to finish in 3rd place with Eddy Jester.

The classified division belonged to Tinh Hoang, as he took the singles (562), all events (1651), and teamed with Po Ling Klip (576) to take the doubles title with 1157.
